CAMPUS AND IN KELOWNA

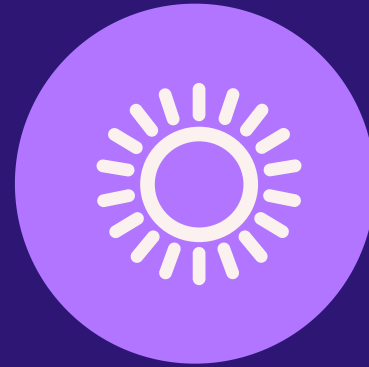


From one initiative to the next, there is always

Professional Communication

- Let your RLM know you're reaching out to someone before you do it, we might already know them!
- Introduce yourself and your role
- Explain what an LLC is if they're a new partner, give a little background on your LLC
- Tell them what you're looking for from them
- Sometimes they don't get back to us right away
 - it's important that you don't show frustration with your LLC partner in front of your residents
